In order for your child to attend Groton Central Schools, you will need to apply on a yearly basis. To apply for consideration as a non-resident student, please complete the enclosed non-resident agreement form and return it to the registrar to be reviewed by the appropriate principal(s).

Once a determination has been made on the status of your child(ren)'s application, you will be notified by the appropriate principal(s). Upon notification that your child(ren) have been accepted as non-resident students, you will complete the official student enrollment paperwork.

In regards to tuition, one half of the annual tuition is due and must be paid before the start of the first semester. The balance must be paid before the start of the second semester. Failure to submit the tuition by the dates stipulated may result in the decision to deny your child(ren)'s application to attend Groton Schools.

NON-RESIDENT STUDENT AGREEMENT

In consideration of my admission as a non-resident student for the school year, the following assurances are given:

- I have read the *Code of Conduct*, and I am familiar with its contents.
- The student will comply with the *Code of Conduct*, and if (s)he does not do so, I understand that my child's non-resident student status may be revoked by the Building Principal after notification to me of the infraction and an opportunity to be heard.
- The student will maintain a rate of school/class attendance of 95%, and if (s)he does not do so, I understand my child's non-resident student status may be revoked by the Building Principal after notification to me of the infraction and an opportunity to be heard.
- I understand that if the required tuition is not paid when due, my child's non-resident student status may be terminated by the Building Principal.
- I understand that the tuition rates typically increase from year to year.
- I understand my child will be eligible to attend/enroll in only those academic programs offered on the Groton Central School campus.
